

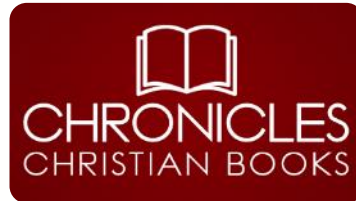

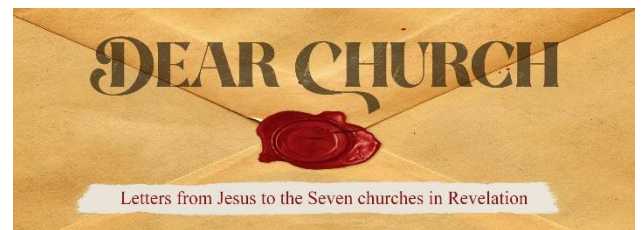

WHEN HE APPEARS

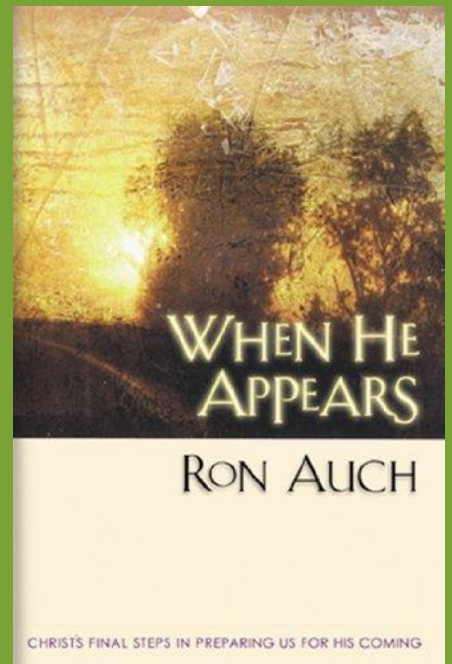

The Song of Solomon is one of the loveliest works in the Old Testament, and is unquestionably the most intimate. Although it is a simple love story between a king and his bride, Bible scholars and laymen alike have had difficulty with it.

Ron Auch brings an insightful approach to the Song of Solomon, first showing it as a historically accurate account of Solomon and his bride by carefully comparing it to other scriptures that relate to Solomon's life. Then, the Song of Solomon is shown as a spiritually accurate allegory of Christ (the king) and the Church (His bride).

The bride is faltering in her marital relationship because of a lack of obedience and intimacy, a self-imposed separation from the groom, selfishness, and the stains of worldly desire. Christ is returning for His bride, but will the bride be ready When He Appears?

NEWS & INFO

Coffee Bar

The coffee bar project is progressing nicely! The original plan was to have it up and running by the end of January however delays in shipping have forced us to push back the opening to the middle of February. Even so, when it starts, it will be a good addition to the foyer. Currently all snacks, coffee, and other refreshments are served next to the kitchen which creates congestion near the bookstore. Moving the snacks to the other side of the foyer will allow for people to spread out a little more as well as making it easier on the volunteers who serve in this ministry. It will also allow us to serve a variety of items and currently the plan is to serve Wawa coffee in 3 flavors (original, dark roast, and hazelnut), Panera Bread pastries (donated to us by Panera at no cost), along with chips and drinks. All items will remain complimentary. Another thing this project will help with is fundraisers. By providing a place to hold food related fundraisers, we can eliminate the need for tables outside the sanctuary.

Baptism Pool

At the end of last summer, we built the baptism pool in the front and it was a huge success! The first weekend we had it open we baptized 19 people in one morning! We baptized another several people throughout the fall before the cold weather set in. You might have noticed the mulch around the pool – don't worry, that's not the final product. The plan is to seed with grass and place benches along with a safety chain around the water, in the spring. The reason for the delay is that by the time the project was done there was not enough time in the season to do all the rest however this spring we will finish those few items.

Roof

Our foyer roof leaked one Sunday in January, but the roof is fine. The issue was some frozen leaves had clogged one of the drains and as the accumulated snow started to melt, it could not drain properly. The issue has been resolved and the following week when we had significant rain, we had no leak. We are now inspecting the roof on a weekly basis to try and prevent this from happening again.

We are currently looking into replacing the roof over the hall and classroom area, along with the roof over the fellowship hall. As you might expect these are costly projects that take much time and planning. The deacons have been diligently meeting with roofers to receive estimates and proposals. More details will be shared as they develop.

It should be mentioned that repairing the roof has not been affected by other projects in the church and this remains a high priority.

Calvary Camp

We are planning for a summer camp for kids. The thinking is that parents of elementary school students still need to find something for the kids to do in the summer. So, we thought, what about offering a 12-week day camp here at the church? Parents would pay to enroll their students, which would pay for the program, but the cost would be less than any other similar program in the area. It would also give us an opportunity to meet new families and develop new relationships.

February Missions

When David and Lee began in ministry it was with Haven of Hope in Philadelphia. Their objective was to be a place where the Gospel is presented boldly, and women imprisoned by drug addictions can have a new life through faith, hope, and strength in Jesus Christ.

Moving on from there David worked at World Evangelization for Christ (WEC) headquarters in Fort Washington, PA. WEC helps local churches strategically focus their mission and ministry. They develop partnerships with missionaries in the field, recruits missionaries, and sends out short-term teams. It was while working here that David and Lee gained a desire to see the people of Morocco reached with the message of Jesus.

Feeling a calling from the Lord to use his gifts and talents to help evangelize and disciple, David is

currently serving as a pastor of a congregation consisting of mostly sub-Saharan African Christians in the country of Morocco. Lee, his wife, is also working with the church in discipleship and women's ministries.

David: "We ask that you pray for us to be able to visit the new attendees of our church; It's hard to fit in all that we have to do. Pray also for the deepening of the spiritual lives of our leaders and that they will resist the huge temptations that are constantly in their face. Pray for the continued progress on the sanctuary enlargement and that we can learn who to go to get the authorization. Please continue to pray for a hunger and thirst for the Word of God by our

church members. At times, it seems like they are mainly interested in miracles, supernatural manifestations and "prosperity" more than the Giver Himself. Lastly, pray that God will draw those who are in the peripheral of the church family into a vibrant relationship with Him."
