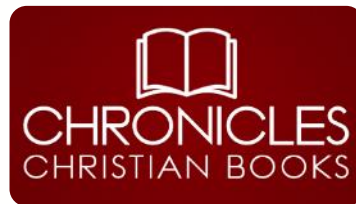

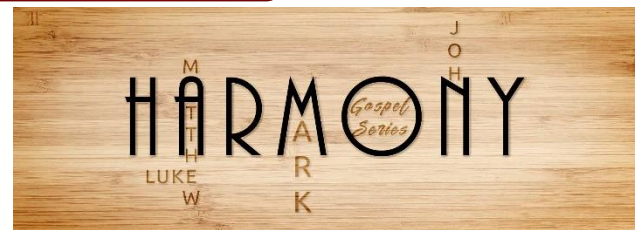

BY JOHN F. MACARTHUR

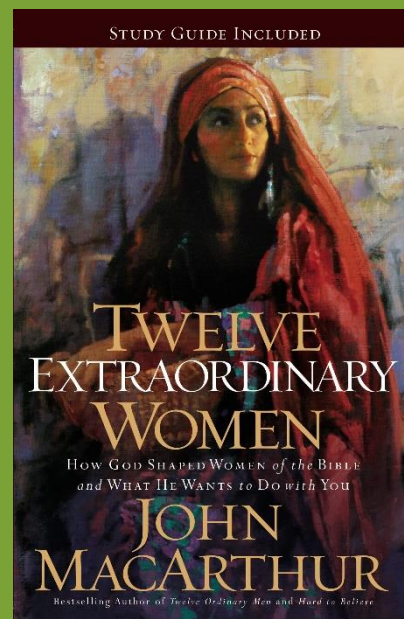
